NCOD REVIEW PROJECT : UPCOMING SCHEDULE

PROJECT INFORMATION

The City of Bozeman is undertaking a review of the Neighborhood Conservation Overlay District (NCOD). The NCOD is a zoning overlay district that was created by the City in 1991 to conserve neighborhood character and protect historic properties. The project team completed the first round of public outreach in July and is scheduled to return in early November. Previous outreach was focused on understanding community sentiment regarding historic preservation, the NCOD boundaries and future development.
