



Bozeman Toilet Rebate Program

This rebate offer is only available to City of Bozeman water customers. **Rebates only apply to [WaterSense® labeled high-efficiency toilets](#) (HET).** Rebates are not to exceed the number of toilets in home or purchase price of the toilet.

Toilet Rebate Application submittals must include the following items:

- A signed and dated Bozeman Toilet Rebate Program Residential Application Form
- Proof of toilet installation: Installation photos and/or certified plumber installation invoice
- Proof of toilet purchase: Itemized sales receipt(s) or invoice(s)

Program Instructions, Limitations, and Terms

Unit must be installed and operational before submitting your application.

1. The rebate amounts listed are applicable only to **WaterSense® labeled high-efficiency toilets (HETs)**. Toilets being replaced must have been installed prior to December 31, 1996 to qualify for a \$125 rebate. Toilets being replaced must have been installed after December 31, 1996 qualify for a \$50 rebate. New construction is eligible for a \$25 rebate per installed WaterSense® toilet.
2. A maximum rebate of \$250 applies per installation address. Contact the Water Conservation Division if requesting a rebate greater than \$250 as funding may be adequate to issue a higher rebate amount. Rebate amounts are not to exceed purchase price of qualifying products and cannot include labor, delivery, or maintenance costs.
3. Tenants must submit an owner-authorized letter to confirm permission for new toilet installation.
4. Only toilets connected to the City of Bozeman public water supply are eligible for rebates.
5. Old toilets cannot be reused. Applicants agree to destroy or disable their old toilet(s).
6. Installation of toilet is the sole responsibility of Applicant and toilet(s) must be installed at the installation address listed on the reverse of this page.
7. A copy of the sales receipt must be attached to this application. Receipts must include the make and model of the toilet(s) purchased. The purchased toilet model number(s) must exactly match the WaterSense® Product List to qualify for a rebate. Mixing and matching of tanks and bowls from this list is not permitted.
8. The effective date of the Bozeman Toilet Rebate Program is March 18, 2008. Rebates for toilets purchased prior to March 18, 2008 will not be given.
9. Applications will be processed in the order they are received. Incomplete applications could be denied and returned to Applicant or result in a delay of the approval of the rebate.
10. To ensure water savings are achieved, the toilet installation must be maintained for a period of five (5) years minimum. If any toilets need to be replaced in this time, the participant agrees to replace the toilets with the products of equal or greater efficiency.
11. Limited funding is available to issue rebates. Rebates will be issued on a first-come, first served basis through the end of the current fiscal year (July 1st-June 30th). Funding may be renewed at the start of the following fiscal year. The City cannot guarantee that submittal of a rebate application will result in issuance of a rebate check. The Bozeman Toilet Rebate Program is subject to change or cancellation without notice.
12. A rebate check will be mailed within forty-five (45) days of receipt provided the application is complete and funding is available.
13. Multi-household property owners seeking to complete bulk retrofit projects at 10 or more dwelling units must receive pre-approval prior to installation of any fixtures. Please contact the Water Conservation Division for information on the pre-approval process.
14. A W-9 Tax Form is **required** of any parties that have been issued a total rebate amount equal to, or in excess of \$600 by the City of Bozeman within one tax year. Applicant must submit a completed W-9 form for the City to issue rebates totaling \$600 or more.

Important! Please Read Carefully

1. Proof of installation must accompany this application. Proof may take the form of an invoice from a certified plumber or a photo of the new toilet(s) after installation. Applications without proof of installation will not be considered for a rebate.
2. The City reserves the right to do an on-site inspection to verify installation of the toilet(s) rebated through this program. Access to the rebated toilet(s) must be provided at the time of inspection. If toilet installation(s) cannot be verified, the payee will reimburse the City for the rebate funds received.
3. The City may contact Applicant by phone or in writing to verify information provided in the application and/or to schedule an inspection. Any inspection shall occur during regular business hours.

Disclaimer

The City makes no representation or warranty regarding the toilets eligible for rebate under the Bozeman Toilet Rebate Program. By participating in the program, you waive and release the City from any and all claims and causes of action arising out of the purchase, installation, or use of the toilets purchased in connection with the rebate program. Any claim you may have based upon any defect or failure of performance of a toilet purchased should be pursued with the manufacturer/distributor. City verification inspections are not a certification, warranty, or other approval with respect to the Applicant's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances and building codes.
